Dear City Resident:

The City of Titusville is currently evaluating automated collection of recyclables from city neighborhoods, and your street has been selected to participate in a pilot test.

On November 23, 2010 City Council authorized staff to proceed with a manual single stream program. Single stream means that we are able to collect all of your recyclables at one time without having to manually sort. Previously, city crews were manually sorting all collection of recyclables at curbside into segregated bins on collection vehicles. Our next progression of the City's recycling program will be to move to a fully automated recycling system.

Your neighborhood has been chosen to participate in a 6 month pilot program beginning the third week of May 2011 to evaluate the viability of the automated recycling program. The first collection day will be Wednesday, May 18, 2011. Prior to the start date you will receive, free of charge, a 65 gallon cart that is to be used when the program begins. The provided cart will replace your existing recycle bin and should be used solely for recycle material. The automated recycling pilot program will entail the consolidation of recycling collections every other week on Wednesday beginning May 18, 2011. The collection dates will be the following:

June 1, 15 and 29	September 7 and 21
July 13 and 27	October 5 and 19
August 10 and 24	November 2 and 16

You should place all your recyclables in this cart for set out on your collection day. There will be no changes to your garbage, yard waste and bulky waste collection, so continue using these services as you always have. At the conclusion of the pilot period a survey will be mailed to each address to be used to evaluate the pilot program. Upon completion of the pilot program and survey period, a recommendation will be made to the City Council to determine the benefits of a City-wide program.
